

CONVERTING RUES STALINGRAD/ BOURBAKI INTO ONE-WAY STREETS

As of 3 August 2020, work will be taking place on the roads Rue de Stalingrad and the southern part of Rue Bourbaki. These works are taking place within the scope of the anticipated development of certain streets located in the heart of the future Flaubert eco-district.

These streets will also accommodate traffic while access to the Flaubert bridge is being developed. During this period, traffic in the area of the work will only be possible in a South > North direction.











THE PROJECT IN BRIEF

The purpose of developing the access points for the left bank at the Flaubert bridge is to create a direct link between the bridge and the dual carriageway Sud III. It consists in building three works of art, creating a complete interchange, and developing certain service roads for the future Flaubert eco-district.



Schedule

The site will be developed in 4 major phases.



Cost and financing

Developing the final access roads to the Flaubert bridge, left bank, is estimated at **EUR 180 million**. The project is part of the State draft Contract - Haute-Normandie region 2015-2020. Within this framework, half of the financing is expected to be covered by the State and the other half by local communities.
